RUNNING FOR CROHN'S & COLITIS UK

Bhavna was diagnosed with Ulcerative Colitis 18 years ago. She has been on a long journey over those years, trying to find a balance of diet, medication and lifestyle to regain some control. She was very unwell, constantly looking for the next available toilet wherever she went and coming up with excuses to decline social invitations. This resulted in her becoming housebound and losing all of her self-confidence.



Unfortunately this is a very common story to hear amongst those affected by Crohn's Disease and Ulcerative Colitis.



"I remember when I was first diagnosed and couldn't get on top of things, I felt despair and depressed. Hopefully this will give others hope that you can live a good life with colitis and still achieve great things" Bhavna says

After meeting her husband Leon, a keen runner and with his help and encouragement, she decided to take on a halfmarathon. Starting to feel more confidence and some

normality in life she tried a 10k, and then after finding some passion she later completed the 13.1 miles Derby Ramathon! This led to a string of personal achievements including some that were completed during mild colitis flare ups which made them even more challenging.

50 parkruns, Leicester Big 10k, Virtual London Marathons and even some climbing in Wales, Tenerife and even New Zealand.

Using these achievements Bhavna is sharing her story to help raise funds and awareness for Crohn's & Colitis UK. So far her Just Giving Page has over £650! This is incredible.

AN UPDATE ON THE IBD NURSING TEAM BY SHARON GETHINS

The Nursing team are available Monday to Friday. We provide a point of contact for all patients diagnosed with IBD in Leicester and Leicestershire.

The Nursing team: Sharon, Tracey, Jodie, and Kelly.

A typical working week involves the answerphone service which is available Monday to Friday morning. During the afternoons the nursing team are involved in clinics that run from all three Leicester hospital sites and in the Community hospitals too. When not in clinic, the nursing team will be following up on calls, and arranging patient management plans, following discussions with your consultant or other members of the IBD team. The nurses want to ensure the correct plan is in place for you and do their best to provide support.



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WHAT'S NEW FOR THE IBD TEAM

We are delighted to share we you all that the team is expanding.

We are being joined by Lauren who will support the team in the day to day running of the service and all that involves supporting IBD patients.

Also joining the Nursing team: Julie and Claire who will be working part time and Femi and Nafida full time. Once they are all in post there will be a phase of teaching and supporting our new team so this will take time, please continue to bear with the team. This is an exciting time which will allow the team to implement new ways of providing support to you all.

THE IBD ANSWERPHONE SERVICE - 0116 2584352

This service continues to be very busy. Calls can vary from 5-10-minutes whereas others can sometimes take longer than 20mins. We know it can be difficult and frustrating to get in contact with the team.

The Answerphone Service is available in the mornings between the hours of 9.30-11.30 and we do listen to each message left. We do ask you listen carefully to the message on the answerphone.

We aim to prioritise calls. If someone is having a flare up then we return their call, before we would call back another patient with blood results.

How to help the Nursing team when

calling the messaging service:

• Please speak clearly

- Leave your Full name
- Have your Hospital number or NHS number?
- Leave your telephone / contact number
- What is the reason for your call: E.G Flare up, Blood results, medications?
- Keep the message very simple as the nursing team will speak with you to find out more.


If you would like to help, please sign up on the website or contact us for more information.

These Coffee Shop Socials are open to all. It is a safe space to talk about Crohn's disease and Ulcerative Colitis. It is also a great way to meet new people and to develop some new relationships. We don't just talk bowels, sometimes it's nice just to chat about hobbies and general life...anything but bowels!

This time we are returning to Jennos Coffee House near Fosse Park. Normally we try to sit upstairs, in a quiet corner. This allows a little bit of privacy just incase the conversation does stray into areas that might make the speaker or other patrons uncomfortable. HOWEVER, Jennos does not have a lift for those with accessibility requirements. So if you would like to attend this meeting and have difficulty with stairs, please let us know BEFORE the event starts. This way, we can make sure we find a seat downstairs, in a more suitable location.

Jennos has free parking for up to 3 hours as well as an area to securely lock your pushbike. It is easily accessible by foot if you are coming from the Glen Parva area. It is next to Fosse Park if you fancied a little shopping before or after the meet up.

On arrival, grab yourself a drink and head upstairs. Your host will be in a purple T-Shirt in front of a huge Crohn's & Colitis UK banner.
