- Representing Crohn's & Colitis UK on a local level
- Volunteering within Crohn's and Colitis UK Terms of Reference, guidance and procedures

- Reaching out to local business and community champions for awareness opportunities
- Liaising with medical professionals to secure speakers and venues for events
- Posting on Social Media and responding to event queries via the platform
- Attending fundraising events and collecting funds
- Running awareness stalls and being at education and social events
- Joining and promoting Crohn's & Colitis UK campaigns
- Writing for and editing the Network's newsletter
