

CROHN'S & COLITIS UK TERMS AND CONDITIONS **2027 THIRD-PARTY EVENTS - CHARITY PLACES**

Crohn's & Colitis UK has limited places in third-party events due to take place throughout 2027. Places are given upon completion of the relevant registration form and full payment of registration fees. Only upon receiving your confirmation email will you have secured your place with us.

The following terms and conditions apply to those successful in securing a charity place:

- You are required to pay the registration fee stated by Crohn's & Colitis UK for the relevant event. This is non-refundable if you are unable to take part in the event. The registration fee must be paid in full to complete the registration form from. Upon completion you will receive a confirmation email.
- You pledge to raise the minimum sponsorship stated on the Crohn's & Colitis UK website for the relevant event (excluding gift aid and registration fees). All funds must be raised and sent to Crohn's & Colitis UK no later than 6 weeks after the event.
- If you choose to withdraw from the event, you must notify Crohn's & Colitis UK as soon as possible. Registration fees are non-refundable, and any sponsorship raised must still be forwarded to the charity or returned to donors if requested.
- We recognise that every supporter's fundraising takes place at different times, both before and after the event itself. However, in our experience we would recommend securing the vast majority of your fundraising prior to the event. To give you some milestones to aim for we suggest aiming to meet the following minimum amounts:
 - At least 75% of your target (excluding Gift Aid) by event day
 - Remaining 25% no later than 6 weeks after the event
- Fundraising will be reviewed regularly to enable us to support the team. We understand that there are often valid reasons for delays with fundraising due to event timings, so please get in touch to discuss this further by emailing fundraising@crohnsandcolitis.org.uk or calling 01727 734485
- You understand you undertake this event at your own risk and understand that it is your responsibility to ensure that you are properly prepared for the activity.
- You confirm that all information about you and consent given to Crohn's & Colitis UK is correct and any changes are notified to Crohn's & Colitis UK as soon as possible by emailing fundraising@crohnsandcolitis.org.uk. You have provided Crohn's & Colitis UK information about you and consent to Crohn's & Colitis UK using this data.
- You understand that it will be necessary for Crohn's & Colitis UK to share the data with the race organiser in order for you to participate in this event.
- You understand that it is your responsibility to read any terms and conditions issued by the race organisers and comply with these.
- You will be required to complete a registration form on the entry registration system for the race organisers (the 'console'). If you do not complete the form by your given deadline, you will lose your place and will not be entitled to a refund of your registration fee.
- You confirm that you will be at least 18 years old at the date of the event.
- You acknowledge that Crohn's & Colitis UK may incur costs as a result of you joining the Crohn's & Colitis UK Team (e.g. cost of producing and postage of fundraising packs / garments) for this event.
- Crohn's & Colitis UK does not provide personal accident or travel insurance for participants. You are responsible for arranging any appropriate insurance cover required for your participation.
- The third-party events are external to Crohn's & Colitis UK, as such Crohn's & Colitis UK shall not be liable for any loss or damage that participants suffer as a result of taking part in the event.
- We cannot defer charity places unless in extenuating circumstances. Please contact fundraising@crohnsandcolitis.org.uk as soon as possible should you be unable to take part in the event.
- You understand that if you are unable to take part in the event, all sponsorship forms and monies collected should be forwarded to Crohn's & Colitis UK or returned to the sponsors.
- All fundraising activities must be lawful and appropriate and must not bring Crohn's & Colitis UK into disrepute. We reserve the right to request that certain fundraising activities cease if deemed unsuitable

- Crohn's & Colitis UK do not sell or swap your details with any third parties. However, in order to carry out our work we may need to pass your details to service companies authorised to act on our behalf. For further information, please see [privacy policy](#).
- You understand that you will be contacted, in reference to the event, via phone, email and SMS.
- You understand that a photographer and or videographer may be present at a Crohn's & Colitis UK cheer point and/or post-race events to capture images and video footage to be used in future charity promotion and marketing channels, including digital and print. By agreeing to these terms and conditions you are consenting to the use of these images which may include you.
