The IBD Standards define what should be put in place at all stages of the patient journey: prediagnosis, newly diagnosed, flare management, surgery, inpatient care and ongoing care, and how the IBD service should be organised to deliver this.

PRESCRIPTION PREPAYMENT CERTIFICATE

DID YOU KNOW YOU CAN SAVE MONEY WITH A PRESCRIPTION PREPAYMENT CERTIFICATE (PPC)?

If you know you'll have to pay for a lot of NHS prescriptions it may be cheaper to buy a prescription prepayment certificate (PPC).

A PPC covers you for all of your own NHS prescriptions, including dental prescriptions, no matter how many items you need. There are two PPC options to choose from:

• A 3-month PPC costs £29.10 and could save you money if you need more than three prescribed items in three months

• A 12-month PPC costs £104.00 and could save you money if you need more than 12 prescribed items in a year

If you prefer talking to someone, you can call the PPC order line on 0300 330 1341.

You can apply by post as well. Just pick up a form from your local GP surgery or pharmacy.

RADAR NKS KEY

If you have a health condition or disability, finding an accessible toilet that's clean, tidy and available for you to use can be a challenge.

The National Key Scheme (NKS) offers disabled people independent access to locked public toilets around the country.

Under the scheme, special locks are installed on public disabled toilet doors to give disabled people priority access.

Local authorities have adopted the scheme and 'Radar toilets' can now be found in shopping centres, pubs, shops, bus/train stations and other locations nationwide.
